#### Consistory News by Charlene Ziegler, Secretary

Consistory met on October 28, 2019.

The Budget and Finance Committee's proposed 2020 Budget was reviewed. There will continue to be a deficit, but less than 2019. The budget will be presented to the congregation during the Congregational Meeting on November 24<sup>th</sup>.

There is an area of carpet in the front of the sanctuary that needs to be replaced or repaired. Several estimates were received from carpet installers to replace all the carpet. Consistory discussed the situation and decided to look into ways to replace the damaged area rather than purchase new. The costs to purchase new carpet far exceeded the amount of money available at this time.

Two Elders and one Deacon on Consistory have completed two terms and will need to be replaced. Two current deacons have agreed to move up to the Elder positions. Three deacon positions will need to be filled. Candidates are being considered.

A donation of \$500 will be presented to the Power Packs Project from the Deacon's Fund.


